A NOTE REGARDING IMPRO AUSTRALIA MEMBERSHIP

Impro Australia Incorporated is a not-for-profit association run by its members to support and promote the art of improvisation. We run three main stage seasons each year at the Belvoir Street Theatre, annual shows (including a celebrity fundraiser) at the Enmore Theatre and a weekly show for new and beginning improvisers at the Clarence Hotel in Petersham. Impro Australia supports and facilitates the activities of affiliated groups in schools, universities and regional areas as well as assisting the improvisational activities of individual members and associated cultural groups. Proceeds from our Celebrity Theatresports® fundraiser at the Enmore Theatre are donated to the Starlight Children's Foundation.

Associate membership of Impro Australia comprises an initial one-off application fee of \$22.00 and annual fee of \$55.00. It costs only \$55.00 to renew your Impro Australia membership for each calendar year after your first year of membership.

In return for this small annual outlay, members are entitled to perform at our weekly Scared Scriptless show and may be cast in our main stage shows at the Belvoir Street Theatre and Enmore Theatre. Memberships fees contribute to the costs of running Impro Australia and help us to provide members with full insurance coverage while performing on stage or working as volunteers on our shows.

In addition, all members are entitled to complimentary tickets (at a value of \$25.00 each) to the opening night of all our seasons at the Belvoir Street Theatre, as well as discounted member concessions to all of our shows at the Belvoir Street Theatre and Enmore Theatre. Even if you only use your complimentary tickets each year then you've more than paid off the annual cost of your membership!

Impro Australia also runs master classes to further develop the improvisational skills of our members and members are provided with access to our Honker email and discussion group so that they get first hand knowledge of what's going on with impro here in Sydney. (If for some reason you aren't subscribed to the Honker and would like to be – or conversely you are subscribed and would like your email address to be removed – then please let us know and we will make it happen.)

And finally, please remember that Impro Australia is a not-for-profit organization run by its members for the benefit of its membership. If you believe that there is something you can do for Impro Australia, or that you have particular skills to contribute to the administration, production or publicity aspects of running a not-for-profit theatre company then please let us know and we'll gladly get you on board. We know that Impro Australia members are a vastly talented and multi-skilled group and we really need everybody to not just pay their fees but also get involved if we are continue supporting improvisation, developing improvisers' talents and promoting the art of improvisation to a wider audience.
